Bardill/Prince 2007 Dances for sets of 5 individual dancers

Jig 5,5,32,5 (10 bar tunes) music "Wee Cooper of Fife" by D Cunningham

Reel for Five Dancers

- 1-2 E&W set as N sets/adv & turns to face W as 5 sets /adv towards 3(S).
- 3-8 1 dances a full [6bar]Lsh reel of 3 across with 4+2, while 5&3 turn $\frac{3}{4}$ RH, chase outside the reel to meet at N then face S.
- 9-10 5+3 set/adv to join reel...5 between 4&1 facing W; 3 between 1&2 facing W white 4+1+3 set with 1(centre) rotating to face E
- 11-20 All dance a full reel of 5 across to end back in start places

[5+4+1+3 start as a Rsh reel of 4. 2, (giving Lsh to 1), joins on 2nd bar]

- 21-24 All set/coupe-in-line with 4,1,&2 facing N, 5&3 facing S
- 25-28 1 dances to N, turns to face S, & stands 2+4 turn to face in & stand 5+3 turn 1 ½ RH (or Birl) to return to starting positions
- 29-30 Points set facing in, 5(centre) sets rotating, to S then to N
- **31-40** 5 swops RH with 1, 1 with 4, 4 with 3, 3 sets to & swops Lh with 2

The title was both a challenge & inspiration. It set the need for the 10 bar figure sequence on which this dance is based. To describe it clearly has also been a challenge...I think the diagram easier to follow...but do persevere..it's fun to dance.
