

## DICK DANIEL'S HORNPIPE

(32 bar Hornpipe for four couples)

Two chords. On the second chord, 2nd and 4th couples change places with partners to start the dance on the opposite sides of the set.

- 1 – 8     1st and 2nd couples dance a men's chain. 3rd and 4th couples dance similarly.
- 9 – 12    1st man and 2nd women and 1st woman and 2nd man set and link. 3rd and 4th couples dance similarly.
- 13 – 16   1st man and 4th woman and 1st woman and 4th man set and link. At the same time, 2nd and 3rd couples set and, giving right hands, cross over.
- 17 – 24   2nd, 4th, 1st and 3rd couples dance eight hands round and back.
- 25 – 32   2nd and 4th couples and 1st and 3rd couples dance left hands across and right hands back.

Finish 2413 with 4th and 3rd couples on the opposite side.

Repeat three times.
